Safety Committees, regardless of the number of employees in the organization or number of members in the association, are encouraged to apply. Nominees will compete with like-sized organizations and associations. Several award winners are expected in this category.

- 3. Describe the safety committee's accomplishments, projects, or recommendations that had a significant impact on the safety and health of workers in the organization. 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Association Award

This award recognizes associations actively promoting workplace safety and health.
